Information pursuant to Article 13 of the GDPR EU Regulation 2016/679

SUMMARY FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG STUDENTS:

Dear Young Artist,

To dance, study, train, participate in the initiatives we organize, take part in performances, and perform on stage, your personal data (name, surname, and personal details) must be included in specific lists, shared with other organizers, and published to illustrate our activities. Your name will appear on posters, websites, social media (such as Facebook), and anywhere we promote our events. Photos and videos of the events you participate in may also be published and shared on the internet.

Our performances, showcases, and many other events are open to the public, meaning everything that happens can be seen by anyone. For this reason, studying and dancing with us implies accepting that this information will circulate freely.

The **Accademia Ucraina di Balletto** guarantees the utmost confidentiality for all sensitive information, such as medical certificates or details regarding injuries or accidents.

If you are a minor, in addition to your consent, we also need the consent of a parent.

FULL PRIVACY POLICY:

Your data will be collected and processed for the following purposes:

School Enrollment:

We will collect the personal and contact details of students, and if they are minors, also those of their parents. These data will be used for enrollment purposes, maintaining student records, and managing specific situations such as medical emergencies, lost and found items, event and lesson invitations, school communications, tuition payments, and even disciplinary matters when necessary.

Participation in Internal Activities:

We will record attendance, academic progress, achievements, injuries, and behaviors in and outside of class, as relevant to AUB's activities.

Participation in External Activities:

AUB takes part in promotional and artistic events with other schools and associations. This requires the processing and sharing of student and artist data. Performances and exhibitions will involve data sharing as necessary.

Your data will be processed for the entire duration of your studies at AUB and retained for 10 years afterward for event documentation. The legal basis for this processing is the enrollment contract and the mutual rights and obligations it entails.

If you do not provide your data, you will not be able to enroll, attend lessons, or participate in activities and events.

All processing necessary for managing the fulfillment of obligations related to educational and artistic activities, as required by regulations and hosting entities, is also provided. The legal basis here is compliance with laws and regulations, as well as AUB's internal rules.

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ADDITIONAL PROCESSING PURPOSES:

Promotion of Social Life and Dance:

Photos and videos may be taken during classes, performances, and other moments at AUB. These may be used internally for educational purposes and shared with AUB's community.

Images and videos may also be used for external promotion on social media and websites, meaning they will be publicly available without restrictions. Once published, they cannot be removed from circulation.

Any participant in AUB's events may be photographed or recorded, and their image may be publicly shared. This is beyond AUB's control, as anyone can post pictures and videos of performances and associate them with the artists' names, AUB's pages, and profiles.

Although we cannot prevent this, we encourage the responsible use of social media.

The legal basis for this processing is twofold: the contract and AUB's legitimate interest in promoting social engagement and school visibility.

Your data will be handled by internal staff and external providers selected for their professionalism and bound by appropriate privacy and security standards.

Data may be shared with entities outside the European Economic Area, provided an adequate level of protection is ensured, in compliance with GDPR standards.

By contacting us via email, you can:

- Request confirmation of data processing,
- Know the origin and location of your data,
- Request corrections or updates,
- Obtain a list of data processors.

Where technically feasible, we will also try to accommodate requests for data portability.

Consent withdrawal is possible only for data where consent is required as the legal basis.

For the identified data processing activities, deletion, limitation, or blocking of processing rights are not applicable due to the legal basis. To object to the processing, you can submit a complaint to the relevant privacy authority at www.garanteprivacy.it.

For publicly shared data (photos, videos, participant lists, publications), the exercise of rights is highly restricted and will not affect already published materials.
